## ◆ 1. Basic Policy



#### 4. Safety management system

#### ◆ Role responsibility

**CEO** Has ultimate responsibility for ensuring the security of transportation for cableway operations.

**Manager** Oversees operations related to ensuring the safety of cableway business transport.

**Safety Supervisor** Supervises the overall transportation of the cableway business and directs and supervises the staff in charge.

**Technical Supervisor** Under the supervision of the Safety Supervisor, management of cableway operations, maintenance of cableway facilities,

Also, oversees operations related to other technical matters.

**Technical Staff** Under the guidance of the technical supervisor, assist the duties of the cableway maintenance.

#### 5. Accident situation and prevention of recurrence

1. Cableway driving accidents: There were no cableway driving accidents in 2018.

2. Incidents: There were no incidents registered in 2018.
